



SMS Commander 1.09 Beta

Some of the changes:

1. Added **cmd:wipecard**. Remotely wipe out or format the external SD card. This command will erase the content of your external SD card.

Advantages:

- a. This new feature is useful when your Treo is lost and you want to wipe out valuable and confidential files saved in your SD card.
- b. If you want to format the external or SD card because of a file system error or corrupted file system. This will freshen up the card and restore some vitality and speed lost over time.

Note:

cmd:wipecard action is irreversible. Once you format the card, all files will be gone permanently.

After performing this command, you may also use **cmd:card** to check the card status. Not necessary, but you cannot be too careful.

Example:.

To remotely format the SD card, just send **cmd:wipecard [your password]** to your Treo.
cmd:wipecard 00000.

2. Added **cmd:register [registration code]**. Remotely register the copy of SMS Commander.

Advantages:

- a. It comes to my attention that several users who purchased SMS Commander™ have overlooked entering their registration code physically and manually to their Treo since it's a setup-and-play software. When the need arises, SMS Commander's trial period has already expired and they could not use it anymore. Now, anytime, anywhere, you may now register it.

b. Like any other Palm app, SMS Commander's Preferences is also susceptible to corruption. This rarely happens and can be caused by other apps. So when this inevitable phenomenon occurs, just remotely register the copy of your SMS Commander and you are good to go.

Example:.

To remotely register your SMS Commander copy, just send cmd:register [your assigned registration code] [your password] to your Treo. cmd:register 1234567890987 00000.

3. Added **cmd:breakdown [on/off]**. Remotely check/enable/disable the *Breakdown to 160 characters option*. Sprint users, please take note of this.

Example:.

To CHECK the Breakdown option status:

Send cmd:breakdown [your password] to your Treo. cmd: breakdown 00000.

To ENABLE the Breakdown option:

Send cmd:breakdown on [your password] to your Treo. cmd: breakdown on 00000.

To DISABLE the Breakdown option:

Send cmd:breakdown off [your password] to your Treo. cmd: breakdown off 00000.

4. Added *Block and notify me if the sender of the command is not the Destination Number* option under the SMS Commander Settings.

Settings ▾ General

Breakdown long SMS into multiple 160-character SMS before forwarding it to the destination number/email address.

If this Treo is with Sprint, you need to enable this option.

Block and notify me if the sender of the command is not the Destination Number.

This security feature has been undocumented and unannounced since version 1.05 Beta. It sends a security notice to the Destination Number when someone other than that number/email is sending a SMS Commander command to your Treo. It is so tough that even Sprint network could not deceive it. Now, we opened it up to the public and set as an option to offer more flexibility.

This feature doesn't affect the Destination Number for SMS forwarding. It will still forward the number to the number set.

Close

If enabled:

a. You CANNOT send a command from any number/email other than the set Destination Number. UNLESS you use **cmd:setnum** to make the number/email in hand as the new Destination Number. If other number/email has been used, security alert will be sent.

If disabled:

a. You CAN send a command from any number/email other than the set Destination Number. SMS Commander will send the response to the sender of the SMS Commander command as long as the password is correct.

b. For Sprint users who are utilizing the network's email-to-Sprint-messaging feature. Let's say you want to send a command from your regular email account to your Sprint Treo through xxxxxx@messaging.sprintpcs.com. You need to put the email address on the Destination Number and disable *Block and notify me if the sender of the command is not the Destination Number* option to receive the response to your email.

Sprint's email address is just a mask for 6245, hence, SMS Commander will reply to 6245 if this option is enabled. And as a result, you will receive an error message from Sprint.

5. Added **cmd:sender [on/off]**. Remotely check/enable/disable the *Block and notify me if the sender of the command is not the Destination Number* option.

Example:.

To CHECK the option status:

Send cmd:sender [your password] to your Treo. cmd: sender 00000.

To ENABLE the option:

Send cmd: sender on [your password] to your Treo. cmd: sender on 00000.

To DISABLE the option:

Send cmd: sender off [your password] to your Treo. cmd: sender off 00000.

6. Added keyguard status on **cmd:status** command response.

7. Updated cmd:help. Added cmd:wipecard, cmd:register, cmd:breakdown, cmd:sender.
