1. Introduction

OffAlready is PalmOS® system utility to protect your Palm from accidentally turning on while in your pocket or in storage and to conserve battery power. The main four hard keys, power button, voice record, camera or any activity that causes your Palm to wake up while its in sleep mode OffAlready will immediately turn the Palm off. The only way to turn on your Palm is by pressing the combination of two hard keys together eg: DateBook and MemoPad hard keys. You can set your own combination. OffAlready also gives you a sense of limited security where other users have to know the combination to turn on the Palm.

Optionally when the Palm is turned you can specify OffAlready to play a Kinoma® video clip from RAM or on the external card.

2. System Requirement

- PalmOS® 3.5 or higher.
- 10K of free memory
- Kinoma® player optional

2.1 Compatibility

- Any PalmOS® 3.5 and higher
- PalmOS 5.x
- Kinoma® Player 1.5 or higher

3. Installation

From the zip archive, unzip the file to your desktop.

To install OffAlready double click on the file OffAlready.prc and then press the HotSync® button on the cradle. The HotSync® manager will install the file OffAlready.prc on to your Palm.

4. Launching OffAlready™



From your Launcher look for the icon  and tap on it to launch it. If you cannot find the icon use the scroll bar and scroll down.

5. User Interface





Diagram 1: OffAlready main screen.

5.1 Select Startup Video



When the Palm is turned on using the combination hard keys the video will be played until you stop manually stop it or launch another application.

5.2 Kinoma® Movies

For best results create the Kinoma® video without User Interface in the Kinoma® producer when you convert the video. Refer to the Kinoma® producer manual.

6. System Soft Reset

After a soft reset OffAlready will re-enabled itself if its enabled before the soft reset.

7. Forgot the Combination

If you had forgotten your combination to turn on the Palm, you can try to guess all the combinations. Since OffAlready only uses the four hard keys there aren't too many combinations you will have guess to get it right.

8. Disabling OffAlready

To disable and uninstall OffAlready just uncheck the **Enable OffAlready!** check box. To delete OffAlready use the Delete menu in the Launcher. No video will be played when OffAlready is disabled.

9. Battery Protection

When OffAlready is enabled and the Palm is turned off any activity that causes the Palm to wake up will immediately go back to sleep. The activity could be an alarm, opening the sled on the Palm TT, press on the voice record button etc... OffAlready offers maximum battery protection against accidental power on.
